Louie and Ruby have completed some very creative ways to show what they have been learning about the layers of the earth.

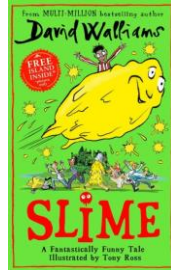


Alfie and Charlie already explored this in their home learning a few weeks ago.

Look, how carefully all of them have they have illustrated or represented each layer.



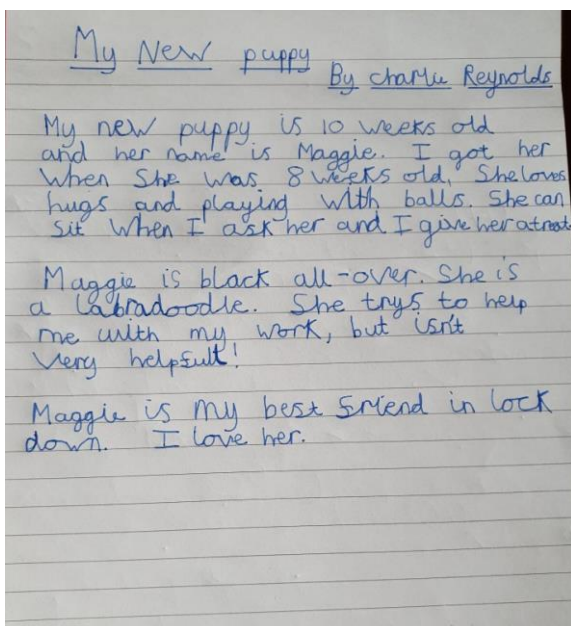
Max sent a lovely picture of the window he painted.
