

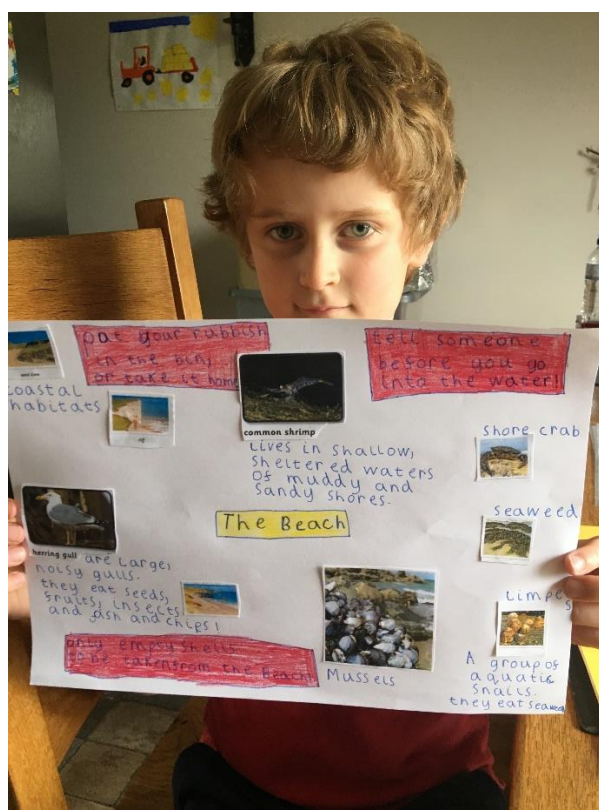
Home Learning 8th June Summer Term 2 2020

Joe sent a lovely picture of his beach poster.



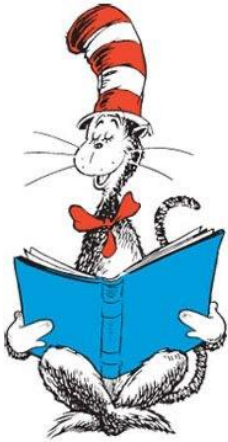
Maths
