

News from the Classes

Carlton Class 1

As Christmas is fast approaching, Little Owls and Reception have been enjoying getting into the festivities. Many of the children have made the most amazing models in the construction area, basing their models on The Christmas story. We've had lots of nativity scenes, stables and journeys around Bethlehem. On Wednesday, Class 1 read the traditional tale 'The Gingerbread Man'. Taking inspiration from the story we got our aprons on and decided to bake our own gingerbread men. A couple of the children were on watch to ensure ours didn't try escaping from the oven. Luckily, all our gingerbread men were well behaved. On Thursday, we had the most exciting part of getting the glittery icing out and decorating our gingerbread. We planned out how they'd like to decorate their gingerbread men by designing them on paper first then applying their ideas onto the gingerbread. All the children demonstrated their brilliant listening skills during this task and enjoyed learning about the old Ladybird books. We hope Class 1 shared their gingerbread with their grown-ups!









Carlton and Bilsdale KS1

What a wonderful week we have had in KS1! The children have again been super busy practising for our Christmas nativity. They are getting more confident with singing the songs and remembering their parts and we are really proud of their hard work.

In Maths, we have been focusing on addition and subtraction, particularly using part/whole models and subtraction by crossing out. We have really enjoyed continuing our work on 'School Days' in history and learned all about Samuel Wilderspoon, who opened schools with playgrounds during the Victorian era. In science we loved learning about pets. We had a great discussion about how to care for pets and classified them into one of the six animal groups, such as birds and mammals.

Bilsdale KS2 and Carlton Class 3 & 4

We may be nearing the end of term but we are not slowing down. The children have been working really hard to complete units of work and embark on new learning to be word and pitch perfect for next week's nativity.

In history, the children have deepened their understanding of the Celts and considered how the development of iron has impacted on invention of tools such as the ard (an early version of the plough), lathe and potter's wheel and how they transformed jobs and daily lives. The children have used this knowledge to write cinquains, five line poems about Iron Age people. The children have also learnt, and can explain, the reasons why the Iron Age came to an end with the older children referring back to their previous learning on the Romans. We have been very impressed with the children's knowledge and history skills this term. They have used different sources of evidence, they can explain the changes within periods of history and give reasons for events. Next term, we focus more on geography with our topic Rocks, Relics and Rumbles.
