Another week has flown by for our Little Owls and Reception children. They have enjoyed preparing for Christmas by starting a few festive crafts this week. The children have talked about the four seasons and which colours are their favourites. We have been continuing to practice our Christmas singing and the children are doing so well. It's nice to hear some of the comments from parents about the Christmas songs the children have been practising at home too!

It was lovely to welcome some new friends into Class 1 on Wednesday afternoon to our 'Stay and Play' - we all had a great time and I was so very proud of everyone. I would like to say a big well done to our Little Owls for making everyone feel so welcome.

### Carlton and Bilsdale KS1

We have had a very productive and creative week, with the children continuing to learn their songs and lines for the eagerly awaited nativity next week. They are all excited to perform for you soon! Our Year 2 children have lived out our vision, showing determination and independence as they have completed their first set of assessment booklets; focussing on maths, reading and spelling. In computing, the children have learnt how to change backgrounds and alter algorithms using 'Maze Explorers', setting challenges for their friends to work through. Forest School on Monday concentrated on knots and lashes, making hangings and Christmas trees from branches, wools and natural materials. A lot of concentration was needed and all persevered. A polite reminder to all for Forest School - please ensure your child has a full change of clothing, lots of layers, wellies and preferably a set of waterproofs. Thank you.

#### Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

KS2 have worked incredibly hard this week. With great focus and determination, they have demonstrated their learning in reading, grammar and maths assessments and also completed units of work in science and RE. Art has required focus and patience as the children have been weaving using wool and small looms. A lot of thought went into colour choices and pattern with wonderful woven designs in production. Well done KS2!

### Carlton Class 3 RE

Our RE unit this half term has focussed on the Sikh religion. As we have been learning, we have collated questions to ask a Sikh - on Wednesday Class 3 welcomed Narinder Singh, a member of the Sikh community, to speak about his faith and answer their questions. The children listened carefully, answered his questions knowledgeably and asked further questions to deepen their understanding. Reflecting on his visit, which the children clearly enjoyed, they appreciated the objects that he brought with him, the stories he told and the music he played.

On behalf of the Rotary clubs of Middlesbrough Erimus, Cleveland, Stokesley and Teesside West who were involved in this year's Wrap Up campaign I would like to thank you for kindly hosting a collection box and supporting this year's campaign. As you will know we sought to collect coats, scarves, gloves, hats and items of warm clothing which we then sort and pass on to charities working with those in need. We have had a wonderful response from all the 54 collection points, this has resulted in 2725 items including 1822 coats. This is a tremendous achievement which far exceeded our expectation.

Since the collections ended, we have sorted and distributed the donations to 12 primary and to 18 charities across the Teesside area. The scope of these donations cannot be understated, and you can take pleasure and pride in the fact that our donations are already keeping someone who is struggling to make ends meet, have a warmer winter this year.
