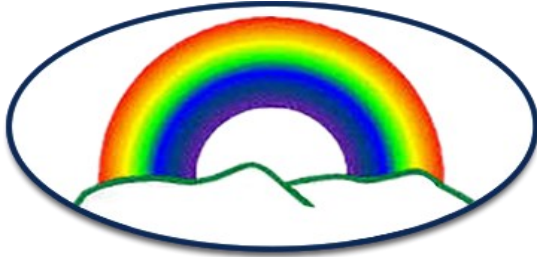

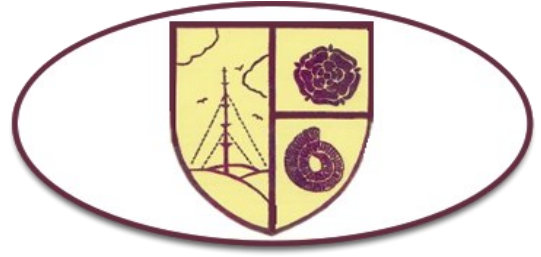

News from the Classes

Little Owls and Class 1

Class 1 and Little Owls have enjoyed beginning their transitions this week! After finding school uniform in the home corner, our Little Owls enjoyed dressing up as big Reception children. They spent all morning becoming familiar with their school uniforms and showed them off to everybody! The Reception children have also enjoyed thinking forward to Year 1 and reflecting on what they have really enjoyed whilst in Reception. We are definitely ready for the next stage of education!

The children were so excited to experience their new classes on transition day. They were ready, respectful and safe all day and showed us that they are ready for Year 2 and Year 3. We are so proud!

We have had a Phonics and Spellings focus this week, working hard to apply all the skills we have learnt in Year 1 and Year 2.

In science, we concluded our work on plant survival by learning about some very unusual plants. We had a great discussion based on parasitic plants (plants that grow on other plants and take their food and are called parasites) and carnivorous plants (plants that get their nutrients from animals, such as insects and amphibians, instead of from the soil).

We also learnt a lot about the Olympics during our 'Picture News' worship and we are looking forward to watching the events later this month!

Looking Ahead. This week in KS2 the wheels of change have started turning. The children have completed their last part of the PSHE jigsaw looking at the cycle of change. Discussions have helped the children to understand that change is normal and worrying about change is normal. With this in mind, they have thought about things we cannot change and how to manage this. A big part of this included what the children are looking forward to as they move to a new year group. As Y6 have had their secondary school transition days, we have held our transition days, enjoying working together in our new class communities. As Year 6 start their journey to leave primary school, each year group begins their own journey and we have been very impressed with how the children are approaching this. It is wonderful to see how the children are able to talk about change so confidently and how their resilience is developing.

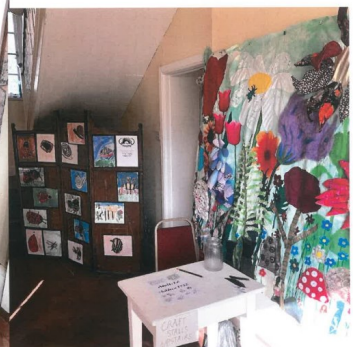
