

Little Owls and Class 1

Class 1 have been exploring the past and present relating to the seaside. We have enjoyed exploring our washing line of old pictures of the seaside and noticing what is the same and what is different. The children were able to identify key aspects of the beach and whether they look the same now or if they have changed. We have even had a go at making a timeline of images, deciding which look the oldest to the most modern. This week the Little Owls have been focusing on expressing their feelings and considering the feelings of others. With the help of 'The Colour Monster' story, accompanied by the colour monster puppets, the children discussed the different emotions and how we can apply this to ourselves in our daily lives.
