

News from the Classes

Little Owls and Class 1

We've had colour mixing fun in Class 1 this week! We thoroughly enjoyed having our colour mixing station in the art area this week. To guide the children's learning a colour mixing session was modelled for the children, then we had a go together and then independently. Although initially browns and blacks were made the children soon learnt techniques to create more bright colours. They were so pleased with themselves and showed such pride, it was really lovely to see. Now all the children show confidence when they need to make a colour independently. Well done Class 1, you should all be so proud!

Carlton & Bilsdale KS1

What a busy week we have had! We had a lovely start to the week enjoying the warmer weather at Forest School. Mr Sims was very impressed with our hard work and skills when printing with leaves. This week in English, Year 2 children have been working hard at using a range of suffixes in their writing whilst Year 1 have been reading a range of alien and real words to support their phonics screening. The children have enjoyed learning more about the life of a pirate which has inspired their non-fiction writing. In mathematics, Year 2 have continued to learn about fractions and have had fun sharing their understanding of halves with Year 1. In geography, the children have enjoyed locating the coastal town of Whitby on a map and identifying the town's physical and human features by looking in detail at the Whitby map, using the key to help.

Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

It's been DT week for KS2. The children have all enjoyed being creative and working in 3D. After refreshing their knowledge about simple mechanisms to make items move such as levers, linkages, sliders, wheels and axles, the children have been introduced to cams and investigated the movements created by using different shape cams. They noticed how a horizontal turning motion creates a vertical motion for the follower. Using this knowledge of cam mechanisms, the children have then designed an automaton toy. It's been great to see the children living our school values this week with the range of skills used: using tools safely, problem solving, resilience and teamwork. Well done KS2!
