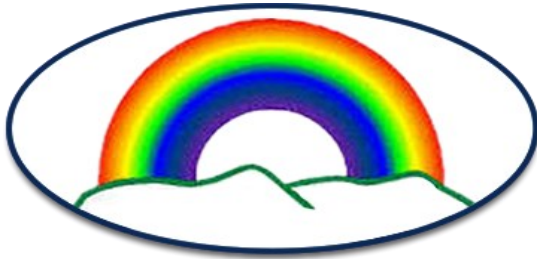

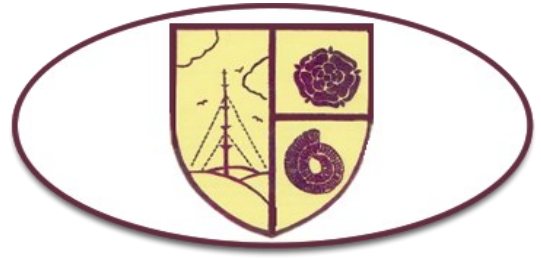

News from the Classes

Little Owls and Class 1

We are truly settled in now and have enjoyed drawing, making music, singing some of our favourite songs and playing with our new friends. Reception have enjoyed starting their Rocket Phonics and in maths we have been learning about matching, sorting and comparing objects.

We have all enjoyed learning more about being part of our school community. We explored together what the word community means before going for a walk around the school to meet people who are there to help us. We asked each person to introduce themselves and explain what they do. We had great fun talking to Mr Scott in his Headteacher's Office.

Class 2

We have had another busy week of learning in Class 2, lots of fun and great examples of our school vision in action.

Monday was our first Forest School session. The children found and identified leaves and trees in our environment. They then collected natural materials to create woodland masks, learning simple threading and knotting skills. Mr Sims explained the importance of layering our clothing to keep us warm or cool us down, so please remember to pack lots of suitable clothing and footwear ready for our next session. On Tuesday we were lucky enough to attend the KS1 Fun Run event at Northallerton, where children from many other schools all took part in the run. The children certainly demonstrated our current value of generosity, giving their kindness and encouragement to all taking part. Despite tired legs, the children ran with determination and smiles and were all proud of their achievements.

In the classroom we have been identifying and discussing human and physical features as part of our 'Wonderful World' unit and have begun basic map reading skills. In Science we have counted body parts and our story of 'Grandad's Island' has been the stimulus for the use of preposition words in sentences. There has been some great discussion on how to stay safe online and we are all eager to continue our learning fun next week.

Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

KS2 have had a fantastic week of writing. All the children have fully engaged with our text 'The Incredible Book Eating Boy' by a well-loved author Oliver Jeffers. They have worked through the first five plot points, word gathering with great enthusiasm and imagination. The Year 3 children have started to challenge themselves and it is wonderful to see Year 6 quickly adding their own original ideas and techniques already showing what great ambassadors for writing they will be this year. The children have used similes, alliteration, and lots of action to show feeling. They have looked at onomatopoeia and selecting precise verbs. It is great to see how well they have engaged with the text and how quickly they are in the writing zone and enjoying themselves. Hopefully they all soon be devouring books and increasing their appetite for reading.

This week has seen the start of our new history topic - 'Invasion'. We revisited the causes and consequences of the end of Roman rule in Britain and the impact of this, finding out that after the Romans left Britannia in AD 410, many towns fell into disrepair and the country became vulnerable to attack. This marked the beginning of a period of invasions from different groups: Picts and Scots from Scotland and Ireland; Anglo-Saxons from Germany, the Netherlands and Denmark; Vikings from Scandinavia and Normans from France. This time in history is called the early Middle Ages. The children are looking forward to finding out more about Anglo Saxons next week.
