Carlton and Bilsdale KS1

It has been lovely to welcome the children back after our Christmas holiday. They were excited on Tuesday to share their holiday adventures and talk to each other about special gifts and family times. The weather this week has helped us with our new science unit, Seasonal Changes. We have discussed what is different about the season of winter, including the changes we notice in daylight hours, changes in weather types and temperatures, how some animals hibernate and some migrate. In geography we are learning about landmarks and how they help us to navigate around the country. We are already looking forward to Forest School on Monday. Please remember to send your child with lots of warm clothing to layer up and wellies, thank you.

Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

We have had a positive and productive start to 2025 with children refreshed and ready to learn. We have discussed setting personal challenges and have already seen work that an improvement on last year. Keep this up KS2!

We have launched our new history theme Ancient Civilisation. The children have been able to describe the features of a civilisation including art, cities, culture, hierarchy, infrastructure, invention, religion, trade and writing. They have started researching the first of three ancient civilisations, Ancient Sumer. Looking at some ancient Sumer artefacts enabled the children to discuss how archaeological finds are important because they tell us about the materials used, the skill of the craftworkers and the life of the owners. We have explored the development of Ancient Sumer including food and farming, inventions and hierarchy. The inventions really captured everyone's interest and included the wheel, writing, a number system and the plough. Lots of good discussions took place as to which was the most important and why. The children have realised that all these inventions helped develop the Sumerians and improve their lives.

Weather Reminder
