

#### News from the Classes

#### Little Owls and Class 1

We have had a fantastic week full of learning and sunshine! In phonics, Reception have been doing some great work exploring the diagraphs ur and ow. They have been busy blending sounds, spotting diagraphs in words and using them confidently in their writing - well done everyone!

In maths, we have been practising our counting skills and are becoming experts at counting all the way to 20. The children are showing brilliant number recognition and accuracy - keep it up!

PE has been lots of fun as we have started our athletics focus. We have been developing our running techniques, running forwards, backwards and even sideways! The children especially enjoyed participating in a fun relay race and working as a team.

With the lovely warm weather this week, Little Owls have been spending more time in our outdoor areas, caring for our plants with lots of watering and attention. It has been wonderful to see the children take responsibility and showing care for nature.

A gentle reminder: on warm days, please ensure your child brings a sun hat, sun cream and a water bottle so we can stay safe and comfortable in the sunshine.

We hope you all enjoy the long bank holiday weekend!

#### Carlton and Bilsdale KS1

What a busy week we have had and how lovely to have some beautiful sunny weather to enjoy. Linking to our science, in Forest School the children learnt about the properties of certain leaves and flowers, then had fun picking and mashing to create a natural 'soap'. They used their creations to clean their hands, then discussed each group's mixes, scents and textures. We have continued our classroom learning on human survival by asking, 'Which needs are most important for human survival?' and 'Which need is most important to you?' discussing their ideas and thoughts. In history we have begun our new 'Movers and Shakers' unit by learning about Dawson's Model. This helps historians decide if a person is historically significant based on the impact they had when they were alive and the impact they have had on modern society. Class 2 became historians for an afternoon, learning about a range of figures, such as activists, artists, monarchs, explorers and doctors, using Dawson's Model to make judgements about the significance and impact each person has had.

Yesterday your child came home with a food diary. Please could you support your child in their science learning on human nutrition and help them complete what food they eat over the next week. When completed please return to school, many thanks. Let's hope the weather continues for our extended weekend, keep up the great work with your reading and Year 1s - keep practising your real and fake words. See you on Tuesday.

#### Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

KS2 have had a productive week working hard in the classroom and enjoying the sunshine outside. In maths, Y3 and Y4 have improved their skills at telling the time on both analogue and digital clocks. This can be tricky as digital time is recorded hours:minutes whereas we say phrases such as "ten past three" meaning the minutes come before the hour. Reading analogue clocks has also been a challenge for some children mastering the minutes to the hour. Any extra practise at home would be helpful. Y5/6 have been tackling algebra, writing expressions and solving equations. They have discovered that algebra can be easy, they are just using all their previous number skills.

This week, we have started our new science topic, States of Matter. The children have identified solids, liquids and gases with some interesting questions "Is custard a solid or liquid?" and interesting discussions about shaving foam, ice cream and toothpaste. We have looked at particle theory to explain the properties of solids, liquids and gases. Our future lessons focus on changing state and will connect with work on the water cycle and our next writing unit.

#### Sun Safety

With the onset of warmer weather, please take note of our sun safety policy which is attached to this week's newsletter email. Children should come to school with an application of sun cream, with a named bottle for additional applications if required. We are unable to share sun cream between children due to allergies.
