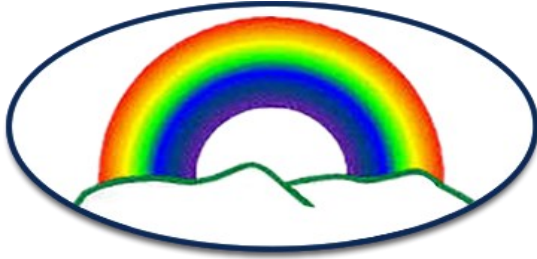

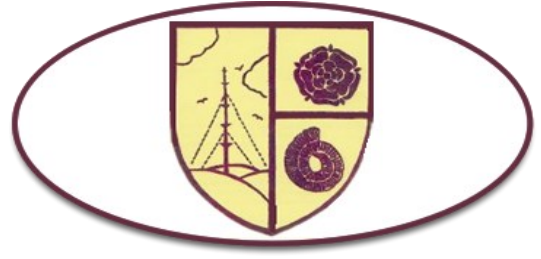

News from the Classes

Little Owls and Class 1

Following on from our topic 'On the Beach', Class 1 have been thinking about pirates! This week Class 1 have enjoyed practising our song of the week 'When I was 1...'. The children have practised altering the speed of the song, singing it in various pitches and altering the words to our own version. If you hear your little one singing this catchy tune at home challenge them to sing the song in a different way. Alongside our beautiful singing, Class 1 focused on cutting skills this week. We are so proud of how far the children have come with their cutting so far this year.

Carlton & Bilsdale KS1

This week we have thoroughly enjoyed our learning in science and have learned more about plant survival. We discussed the ways trees and plants change with the seasons. It was great to get outdoors into the school grounds and observe plants. We had some really good answers to the questions: 'What season is it now?' and 'What plants would we expect to see at this time of year?'

On Monday afternoon, Year 2 enjoyed being gardeners and had fun tidying up the flowerbeds. They worked hard, despite the heavy downpours and managed to plant some pumpkin plants and sunflower seeds.

In geography this week we learned about Saltwick Nab and its dangers. We used Google Earth search tool to locate Whitby and made observations about any physical and human features observed, based on our prior learning. We now know that Saltwick Nab is a rocky platform situated off the coast of Whitby which is, at times, hidden by the sea. We considered the dangers of such a feature and listened to the story of SS Rohilla.

Well done to all our children who took part in the phonics screening check this week. We are incredibly proud of you all.



Carlton and Bilsdale KS2

Do you think KS2 should complete SATS? Should we feed animals in the wild? School uniforms - good or bad? Some of the questions that KS2 have been discussing in order to write a balanced argument. This has involved exploring different viewpoints and developing tolerance for, and understanding of, opposing views. There has been some passionate debating and emotive writing.

In maths, Y3 and Y4 have been using and applying their calculation skills with money. Y5 have completed work on decimals whilst Y6 have been working through a bakery challenge. They have worked on costing, profit and loss, packaging and timings. They are looking forward to our baking day at Bilsdale. Look out for some tasty treats soon!

About Parent Carer Voice North Yorkshire

Parent Carer Voice are the recognised Parent Carer Forum for North Yorkshire, supporting families with children and young people (0-25 years old) with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND). Their vision is to inform, empower and represent the collective voice of families with SEND in the region. They are a community, connecting families through shared information, experiences and mutual support. They know how isolating and confusing it can be to navigate services and family life with SEND, so they organise events and training across North Yorkshire and share information with the aim to inform and empower families. They work together, using their collective voice for positive change. They work closely and co-productively with their strategic partners and service providers such as the Local Authority and Integrated Care Boards to help improve services and support for families.

Cancellations/Refunds

Cancellations of training events are subject to a 25% administration fee where the cancellation is made 3 weeks or more before the date of the event. No refund is payable for a cancellation made within 2 weeks prior to the training course – in this event the full sum shown on the invoice remains payable.
